I want to share with you today about how the situation in Haiti has affected our Children's Homes, and Pastor Poyis specifically. Ministry happens under every variety of circumstances, and there are so many reasons to praise God, even as we ask Him for help through these times.



CV and his wife are living at the Children's Homes now, and both of them have started work in their roles there. It has been a wonderful blessing for our kids to have both a man and a woman caring for them. The children know generally about the struggles in Haiti, but because of faithful men and women like this, their daily experience is of being safe, secure, fed, and loved. Thank the Lord for His provision.

Pastor Poyis is one of my favorite examples of remaining faithful in ministry. Over the past months, many of Poyis's friends, neighbors, and ministry contacts have left Haiti and moved to other places, including the US. These are people who had the means to leave,

and did so when they saw opportunity. For Poyis, it's less a matter of having the means, and more about having a commitment to ministry in Haiti. He's chosen to stay and put his own life at risk in order to continue serving his people. He has been called and is a wonderful model of obedience to that call.

One thing I'd encourage you to do is to send letters to us that we can relay to Poyis by way of encouragement. It's hard to be present from a distance, but there are ways we can bridge the gap. Poyis truly is a missionary in every sense. He could leave, but he's chosen to stay in a situation where it's potentially very dangerous for him, and that commitment to the ministry is a testimony of God's work in the hearts of His servants.
