FROM THE FOUNDER

Each month, I hope I'll be able to write more encouraging news for you about Haiti. While political tensions continue to rise and create challenges for ministry, I am still amazed at how God provides.

In the last few weeks, a gang in Haiti created a blockage to the fuel source, causing a myriad of issues, including famine. Our team continues to thank God for His provision of food for our Children's Homes and churches in our Mercy Network through our partnership with Children's Hunger Fund. Our current food supply should last through the end of the month. We continue to pray for opportunities to share food and the Bread of Life with our Mercy Network pastors' communities.

Our Children's Homes remain a place of safety and peace. While the children are aware of some of the issues their country is facing, Pastor Poyis and CV continue to shepherd them in the hope of Christ. Pastor Poyis and I don't see cholera being much of a problem for



our Children's Homes, as our water cisterns are unaffected by very unsanitary conditions in other parts of the country.

Just a couple weeks ago, Pastor Michelet and Pastor Marcellin were both able to give away packages our rescued children put together, which included Audio Bibles, Creole Jesus Storybook Bibles, toiletries, and basic medical supplies. These distributions were evidence of God's faithfulness and provision through you, our faithful supporters, and your support of the ministry and our pastors who press on for the gospel in the face of adversity. We are praising the Lord for continued opportunities to share the love of Christ with the people of Haiti.







I have two requests for you today. First, I would like to ask you to keep an eye on current events in Haiti. We are beginning to finally see some attention from the international community on the country's crisis. This is good news. Second, I would like to ask you to pray diligently for our pastors and their churches, our in-country staff and their families, our rescued children, and the children who need to be rescued.








Salvation for Prime Minister Ariel Henry, his staff and cabinet, and Haitian gang leaders and members.
