Thank you for your continued prayers and support. We certainly need them. Just a couple days before Easter Sunday, Pastor Poyis called me to let me know that the gangs had once again pushed into Onaville. Anyone able to leave Onaville has left. Pastor Poyis sent me a photo of an empty church on Easter Sunday—a sad sight to see.



Pastor Poyis and Esther have provided refuge for Pastor Michelet and his family in the compound. CV remains with the children at the Homes. We thank God for His hedge of protection around the compound and Children's Homes. We're also thankful for a month's supply of food and water that are available at the compound.

I am hopeful that the police will be able to come in and drive the gangs out of Onaville as they have done before. This would allow for some level of normalcy for ministry.

This has been the most difficult aspect of ministry in a third world country. Although it seems bleak, I know the Lord is still at work. I trust that in the suffering, He is working to further His kingdom work.

Please continue to pray with us for a hedge of protection around our staff and children in Haiti. Please continue to pray for intervention. Please continue to pray for God to provide access to food, water, and other supplies. Please continue to pray for all of the pastors in our Mercy Network, the children in our Mercy, Regency, and Sheepfold Homes, and for all our indigenous staff, as well.

I hope that next month I'll be able to share better news with you. In the meantime, thank you for praying with us.
