

This Christmas, each one of the children at the Regency Home will receive a Bible, thanks to those of you who generously supported our desire to expand their library. They are so excited to have their own Bibles! I wish more of us could be excited about the reality of having the very words of God in our hands. This is overwhelming for them. Praise God for the amazing healing He has done in their lives.

Thanks to you, 59% of our Regency Home Children now have sponsors! Additionally, we are excited to announce the completion of the second dorm. Between January and June, we will welcome more than eighty new children into the Home in groups of eight to ten. This will allow the new children to acclimate into their new lifestyle, and give an opportunity for the Home staff to focus on meeting their immediate needs. Our children are so excited to welcome in new brothers and sisters.
