FROM THE FOUNDER

The Lord has blessed us richly in reopening doors for ministry in Haiti. Over the last few months, we have begun taking American-based teams to our new compound. We have started construction projects and are laying down roots in the central plateau area. As we enter the spring season, I want to share some updates and prayer requests regarding our ongoing work in Haiti.

We are making progress in getting our two dorms ready to provide permanent housing for our children. The septic system has been walled up, and while it's not fully covered yet, we're optimistic that this can be completed soon. Our goal is to build the second dorm, install another storage facility, and begin construction on the church by the end of June. One challenge in all of this has been the weather in Haiti—the ground is wet, and we are praying that things will dry out soon to speed our projects along.

We are also hopeful about opening a medical clinic on the new compound soon. We anticipate many doctors and nurses who temporarily relocated to the U.S. will need to settle in a new location when they return to the country because the healthcare situation in Port-au-Prince remains challenging. Our clinic could be a useful solution on many levels. While there is a decent hospital in the central plateau, it operates on a pay-for-service basis, leaving many without the help they need. We aim to provide support to those with limited resources, creating jobs for skilled Haitian medical professionals in the process.

I envision a robust outreach program by the end of summer, anchored first by our church and secondarily by our clinic. This initiative will help us meet pressing needs in our community, especially as we seek to distribute food and essential resources with the goal of sharing the gospel.

Thank you for your continued prayers. Your support and faith are a constant encouragement to me.

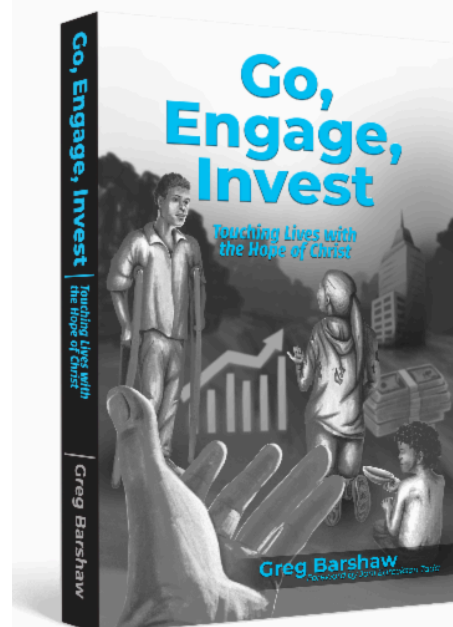

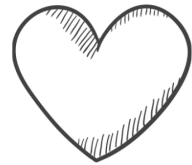
