FROM THE FOUNDER

One of the joys of ministry is seeing how simple acts of faithfulness can transform the way a community views the church. When our church in Haiti started twelve years ago, one of the first outreaches we organized was a Mother's Day food distribution. We were building a presence and building relationships as a result. This year, we were able to continue that tradition. Below, I'm sharing some photos from the church's twelve-year anniversary celebration, along with highlights from the Mother's Day outreach.



This distribution was encouraging in more ways than one. We were able to provide 250 food bags to mothers in the local community, and each bag was filled with practical staples like rice, beans, cooking oil, canned fish, spaghetti, and other kitchen essentials. This kind of tangible aid goes a long way to help a family in need. Even more significantly though, the outreach created another opportunity for the church to build

meaningful relationships with families in the area. This is what it looks like to be the hands and feet of Jesus.



I'm excited that the community is beginning to see the church as a place of hope. Our recent volunteer team helped facilitate a medical clinic, which strengthened these community ties. The US volunteers worked alongside our Haitian-led medical team, and they were able to perform well checks for all of our kids, our staff, and 253 people from the community, for a total of 327 people served. Because the surrounding area is deeply impoverished, many mothers brought young children who had never seen a doctor before. We were able to give them much-needed resources, too, such as baby clothes, children's shoes, and Manna Packs. Most importantly, every clinic visitor left with a copy of an audio Bible, and they had heard the gospel during their time with us from our staff and volunteers. Thank you to everyone who donated to make this trip a reality. Here are some photos from the clinic.



What's amazing though is that even after the medical team returned home, ministry continues. The church remains active in one of the poorest and most spiritually challenging areas of the region, faithfully serving children, families, and neighbors with the love of Christ. These outreaches are opening doors for future ministry opportunities, including additional medical clinics and church outreach efforts. This is our four pillars of ministry—biblically focused, church centric, compassionate relationships, indigenous ministry—in action.

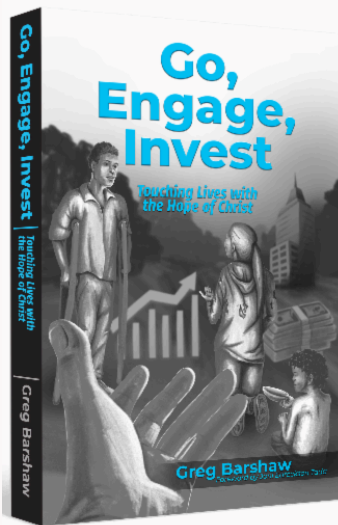

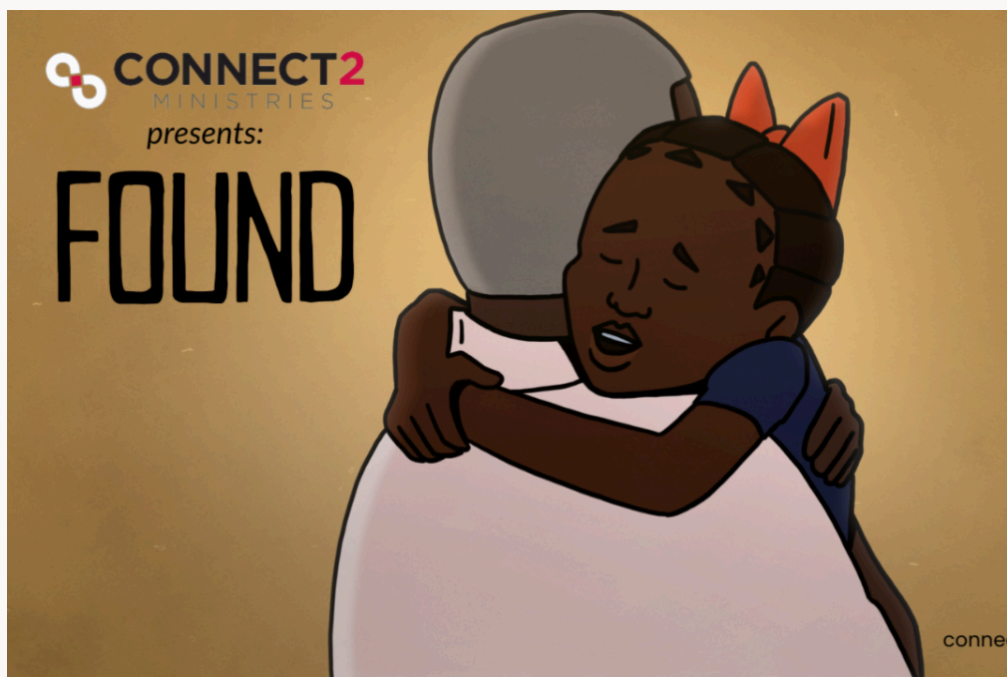
